## NEWSLETTER - MAY 2017

Dear Global Asthma Network colleagues and friends,

Greetings to you all from the GAN Global Centre, Auckland, NZ. We hope that many of you have now begun your fieldwork and look forward to receiving your data and Centre Report in due course. In this newsletter we have some important information regarding your field work, which you may find useful. For example we encourage you to complete the Centre Report on line via the website for the 13/14 and 6/7 year age groups (there is no Centre Report for the Adult group) as this ensures all the information is captured in a data base (see next page).

We now have registrations from 117 centres from 49 countries. If you have started fieldwork but not yet registered we would be grateful if you could please do so via the website. http://www.globalasthmanetwork.org/surveillance/register.php

GAN put out a press release for World Asthma Day on  $3^{rd}$  May this year, and this is on the GAN website.

At the European Respiratory Society (ERS) conference in Milan, Italy (Saturday September 9<sup>th</sup> until Wednesday the 13<sup>th</sup> September), there will be an informal GAN gathering of collaborators and Steering Group who are attending. We would love to see you. We will let you know before the conference where we may meet up with any of you that attend. The GAN Steering Group will be holding their annual meeting in Murcia, Spain, on 6 & 7 September, prior to the ERS meeting and we will report back to you about any new developments.

We have included some photos of our collaborators in GAN centres and from the ERS. I encourage you to keep sending items in for inclusion in future newsletters for interest.

Funding for the central coordination of GAN in Auckland, for Philippa and Eamon continues to be challenging, however we continue to explore funding opportunities.

## GAN Phase I Fieldwork report – Philippa Ellwood

- 1. Participation of the 13/14 year age group is the compulsory requirement for inclusion in GAN Phase I. However we strongly encourage you to include the 6/7 year age group AND the Parents/Guardians (Adults) of both the 13/14 and 6/7 year age groups as this will provide us with a rich family history. Additionally, we will be able to gain a more comprehensive picture about the environment and the protective and risk factors that emerged from the ISAAC Phase Three analysis. If you do include the Adult group it is vital that you link the 13/14 and 6/7 year age group questionnaires with the Adult group by using the "Office Use Only" boxes. Please see Section 20 of the GAN Phase I Manual which has detailed instructions on how to achieve this.
- 2. We would appreciate it if you could complete your Centre Reports (13/14 and 6/7 year age groups) on line via the website as this avoids the need to re-enter the information manually. You will find a link to the Centre Report under the "Surveillance" Tab on the GAN website.
- 3. Remember, each centre owns their own data and collaborators are free to publish this once the data and Centre Report checks have been completed. It is important that no data is published before the checks have been completed to ensure the data sets are compatible and exactly the same. The GAN Global Centre would appreciate a copy of any publication that you undertake being sent to the GAN Global Centre, so that these can be put on the GAN website under the publication section.
- 4. Principal Investigators (PIs) whose data is included in any worldwide publication will be listed and acknowledged in the appendix of each worldwide publication, along with the name of the PIs institution. As two PIs per centre are allowed (one for each age group), the PI that is involved in each age group analysis will be named appropriately.
- 5. You may, through your institution, have access to REDCap which is a free, web-based and user-friendly electronic data capture tool. This is an alternative to the Epi Info package which is available from the website in the GAN Phase I Manual in the Coding and Data Transfer Section (Section 19). If you wish to explore the use of REDCap further, you will need to find the appropriate contact person through your institution.


### **Social Media**
